



FUNDING AVAILABLE FOR LAND MANAGERS & COMMUNITY

Reef Catchments is seeking to partner with land managers and community groups to undertake on ground works that may include land type fencing, riparian fencing, off-stream water points, revegetation and weed management, including fire and fire management. Critically, these works must serve to protect and enhance land area nationally recognised

as having high ecological significance. Therefore, eligibility is dependent on having Matters of National Significance on or in close proximity to your property. To see if your property is eligible please contact Reef Catchments. Cash incentives, of up to 50% of the project cost, are to be negotiated upon assessment of the ecological value of the proposed works.
