
REEF PROGRAMME SYSTEMS REPAIR



Reef Catchments has been awarded funding through the Australian Government Reef Programme to undertake Systems Repair works across the three major river basins of the Mackay Whitsunday region. In the O'Connell Basin activities will focus on natural systems, with in-stream works such as barrier removal, bank stabilisation, fishways and riparian revegetation.



ELIGIBLE ACTIVITIES IN LETHE BROOK, THOMPSON CREEK, O'CONNELL & ANDROMACHE CATCHMENTS

Riparian fencing & off-stream watering points

Riparian revegetation & weed control

River and creek bank and bed stabilisation

Gully stabilisation

Removal of fish barriers and installation of fishways

Natural wetland rehabilitation

HOW DO I APPLY?

- 1. Complete 'Expression of Interest' (EOI) form
- 2. Once received, we will contact you to inform you on eligible activities and gather more information
- 3. A project officer will contact you to confirm a property visit, to assess potential projects and provide support to the land manager during the project
- 4. Once your project has been approved a contract will be forwarded with milestones for you to read, sign and post back to Reef Catchments (funding milestones are for completion in the same financial year the project is approved)
