Reporting to the Coordinator – Sustainable Agriculture, the Officer will assist landholders with property planning designed to improve land condition and water quality outcomes as well as provide extension services to agriculture landholders and technical support to Reef Catchments programs, in particular, providing landholder engagement and communication support for Sustainable Agriculture programs.

The Officer will provide technical and management support to demonstration trials, develop and maintain effective relationships with stakeholders and landholders to aid the development of sustainable agriculture projects, support the data collection and analysis of management practice adoption to evaluate the program's effectiveness and enable program modifications in relation to extension and funding.
